FURTHER READING:

This structural succulent plant grows to 1 metre tall with evenly-spaced thick triangular dark gray-green leaves, that have smooth margins and a prominent sturdy terminal spine, which growers need to be careful of. This plant is a naturally occuring hybrid of the ferdinandii-regis form of Agave victoria-reginae crossed with Agave scabra.
