### FURTHER READING:

Once the plant is established, which is relatively easy to do, it becomes even easier to care for them. They need to be in soil that drains well and placed in the sun. During summer water weekly.

*Growers note: I have seen these plants growing in 'islands' of about 2.5 x 7 metres. Undulating dense green mounds too thick for weeds to establish - awesome!*
